

**** Lions Gun Range ****

February 19-21, 2010

Location: Bountiful Lion's Club shooting range (north of the "B")

Pre-load: Thursday, February 18, Elks Lodge 645pm.

Departure: Leave Elk's Lodge Friday February 19 at 5pm

Return: Arrive at Elk's Lodge Sunday, February 21, probably 11am.

Cost: \$10.00 per Scout. Adults are Free but must RSVP.

Remember- the troop does not accept sign-ups after pre-load! **This camp is for rank advancement and recreational shotgun and rifle shooting. The shotgun or rifle shooting merit badges will not be offered.**

Shooting will be from 1pm until 5pm Saturday. All scouts will be allowed to shoot with range and troop provided supervision. **We will need extra help for scouts age 11-12. Parents- please volunteer to assist.** In accordance with BSA policy- all rifles must be single shot .22-caliber rimfire only. A repeating 22 with a clip is OK (e.g. Ruger 10-22) if fired single shot. NOTICE-No centerfire rifles, no semi-auto 22's, no tubular magazines, no 10 gauge shotguns, no muzzleloaders and no pistols are allowed. If you want to shoot these guns, it must be on your own, with your own supervision and only before or after event times- i.e. the troop is not present. The scouts must provide their own ammunition for all shooting. Shotgun shells should be target loads, NOT hunting loads. No shot larger than #6 allowed. The troop will provide a few cases of clay pigeons and paper targets. Bring clays, clay launchers, rifles and shotguns if you have them. They must be unloaded (check twice!) and cased to transport. There is no extra range cost. Scouts must provide ear and eye protection. Foam earplugs are for sale at the range. Ear plugs are also good for sleeping at night.

This is a camp specific list. Please consult your BSA handbook and/or BSA field book for other items.

- OK to bring card games like Magic and board games like chess for the evening. No electronic games.
- Summer weight sleeping bag & air mattress or foam pad & tarp to cover the dirty floor.
- Personal first aid kit and personal mess kit (fork, spoon, knife, bowl, cup, plate etc.)
- Common sense for gun safety. Horseplay will not be tolerated around guns.
- No tent needed as we will be sleeping in the clubhouse. It's heated and has lights.
- Personal hygiene kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, etc.). Earplugs for sleeping.
- Flashlight (that works) as restrooms are outside port-o-potties, bring sunscreen.
- Bring boots for outdoors and shoes/mocs for indoors. Bring clean dry clothes to sleep in.
- Watch the weather forecast for proper clothes to bring. Bring a good coat, hat, and gloves.

We both hereby release from liability all persons and/or organizations who in any way have helped in organizing, planning, transporting for, and/or implementing the activity. Talent release and waiver- I understand Troop 220 may post photos taken of the scouts during this activity on its website. Occasionally the troop may distribute photos on digital media. I am allowing the troop to post and distribute photos of my scout and release leaders from all liability regarding the photos. I expect no remuneration for photos.
