

**** MILL HOLLOW CAMPING/FISHING ****

July 30 - August 1, 2010

Location: Mill Hollow Reservoir is located 20 miles southeast of Kamas on route 35.

Pre-load: Thursday, July 29, 2010 Elks Lodge **6:45 PM**.

You must preload to camp or have pre-authorized approval by a leader to miss preload.

Departure: Leave Elk's Lodge Friday, July 30 at **5:00PM. (Be there no later than 4:45)**

Return: Arrive, unload, clean-up at the Elk's will probably be done by 11:30am Sunday August 1.

Cost: \$15.00 per scout for those that are not bringing an adult to drive. \$10 per scout if they bring an adult to drive and they drive other scouts and their gear. We will stay in the campground.

Adults- free to eat/ tent camp w/troop. All adults must RSVP by pre-load.

Activities: **fishing merit badge will be offered and you can complete it at camp. Scouts need to have a valid fishing license. Anyone 12 years old or older must have a license to fish in Utah.** Rank advancement provided as needed. This should be a great camping and fishing weekend.

Essential equipment to bring and camp specific information

- ◇ Pre-made dinner for your Friday night meal. Personal hygiene kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, etc.)
- ◇ Appropriate sleeping bag for the season & air mattress/foam pad/ground pad & pillow.
- ◇ Personal mess kit (fork, spoon, knife, bowl, cup, plate etc.) Don't forget part of it!
- ◇ Common sense (remember- no fires, candles or flames of any kind allowed in tents, ever)
- ◇ Rain gear or poncho and 2 large garbage bags to cover gear in rain. Personal first aid kit.
- ◇ Tent & ground cloth (if you have one or find someone to share before we leave).
- ◇ Bring sunscreen, sunglasses and wide brim hat. Long sleeve white shirt is great for sun protection.
- ◇ Watch the weather forecast to fine tune clothing for the weekend. The camp is at 8800 feet.
- ◇ Clean warm clothes to sleep in. A folding chair is handy to have in camp.
- ◇ This is an established campground with restrooms and water. Bring a flashlight (that works).
- ◇ **Bring all your own fishing gear and tackle.**
- ◇ Bring a fishing license if your age needs one. Follow fishing rules.
- ◇ Standard baits like fly/bubble, power bait, spinners, and worms are OK. We can cook some fish too.
- ◇ Electronic games/ipods, etc. are not allowed in camp. They may be used in the car if the driver OKs it.
- ◇ Scouts may NOT possess or consume energy drinks (RedBull, RockStar, etc) at any time.
- ◇ **Sign up and pay on July 26 at troop meeting. Sign-up at Preload is OK if necessary.**
- ◇ Troop does not take sign-ups after pre-load or at departure. Wear Class B shirts all weekend.
