

- MERIT BADGES OFFERED LOCALLY – (updated 12-09)

**Tip** - get all 12 of the eagle required merit badges done as soon as possible, because your scouts should have all 12 eagle required MBs by their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday and absolutely by their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday at the latest. Don't procrastinate!

**Parents** - are responsible for signing up their scouts for eagle required MB classes, because the troop does not offer these, since they are readily available locally.

**Bountiful high school** – In September, January and March, a newspaper is mailed out to homes with class schedule. Citizenship/nation, citizenship/community, citizenship/world, environmental science, communications and first aid. Also safety, bird study and insects.
